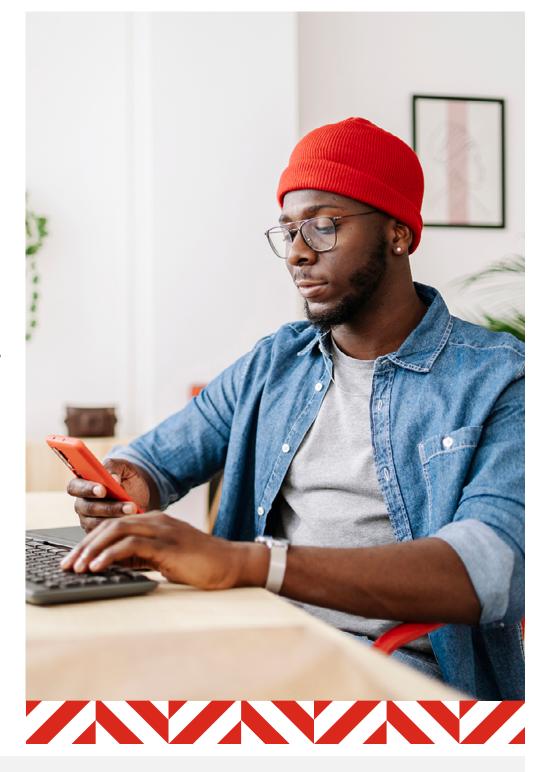
What's the Most Convenient Implementation Option for Me?

Click-to-Call (for Microsoft E3 or below licensing)

With Click-to-Call, the user initiates a call through the Teams UX, which launches an Avaya soft client to dial the call.

Direct Routing (for Microsoft E5 licensing)

With Direct Routing, the user initiates a call through the Teams UX, as a full native Teams experience.





Avaya Integration Benefits

- **Flexibility** Avaya offers flexibility with both Click-to-Call and Direct Routing integration with existing Avaya telephony infrastructure.
- Major cost savings Click-to-Call integration with Avaya only requires Microsoft E3 licensing, a significant savings of \$15 to \$21/user/month vs. the cost of Microsoft E5 licensing required for Direct Routing. While many organizations will have E3, the additional costs for E5 licensing can be major; for example, with 2,000 users, the additional cost can be \$500,000 per year.
- Native Teams environment Enterprises can get the pure Teams environment, and if there are any issues with Teams, they have a fully functioning Avaya phone system behind it.
- Use existing carrier services Organizations can continue with their existing carrier contracts.
- More control Companies have more control over their telephony environment.
- Business continuity Firms have their existing softphone and video meetings entitlements for business continuity. If Teams goes down, customers can continue with their Avaya applications.
- **Reliability** Avaya can deliver 5-9's uptimes, which is 5 minutes of outage per year.
- Microsoft Certified Avaya Session Border Controller for Enterprise
 (SBCE) is a Microsoft certified SBC that provides integration with the Direct
 Routing feature of Teams.

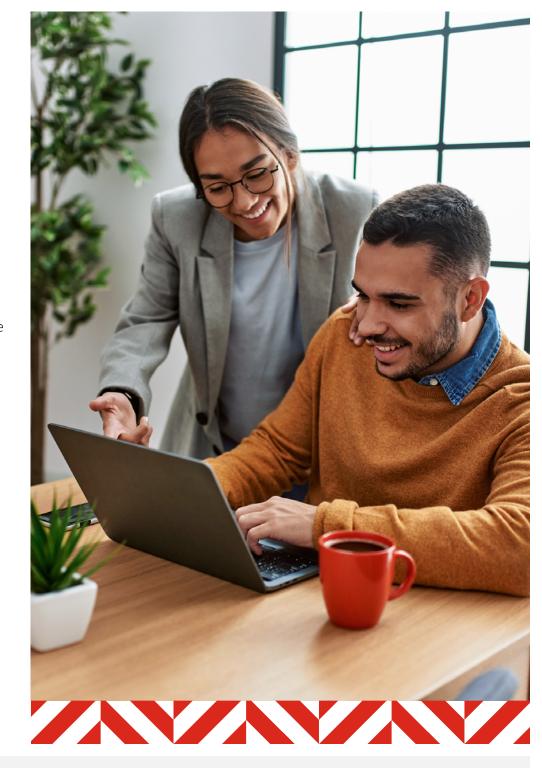

 UC User profile.

Licensing and Costs for Teams Telephony Without Avaya Integration

You can easily enable integration with your existing Avaya telephony platform; or you can choose one of Microsoft's options. With both Microsoft 365 E3 and E5 licensing, you must purchase a calling plan with added cost.

Microsoft 365 E3 Enterprise Plan:

- Includes access to Microsoft 365 apps including Teams.
- Does not include calling between Teams users.
- For an additional \$8/user/month, or by moving to a Microsoft E5 plan, Microsoft Teams Phone Standard enables calling between Teams users; but this isn't a calling plan.
- Calling outside the Teams environment (landlines, mobile phones, etc.)
 requires an additional calling plan via Microsoft Operator Connect, Direct
 Routing, or the Teams Phone with Calling Plan bundle at an additional cost.

Microsoft 365 E5 Enterprise Plan:

- Includes access to Microsoft 365 apps including Teams.
- An increase of \$21/user above E3 for Microsoft 365 for Enterprise, or \$15/user for Office 365.
- Includes calling between Teams users through Teams Phone Standard, bundled in the E5 plan.
- Like above with Microsoft E3, Teams Phone enables Teams to Teams user calls, but organizations still need to purchase a calling plan for external connectivity.

Avoid Expenses of Teams Calling Plans and More Licensing with Avaya Integration

Avaya offers flexibility with both Click-to-Call and Direct Routing integrations.

Organizations can continue with their existing carrier contracts while maintaining control over their telephony environment.
